Currently there are over 200 parents on the waiting list to participate in future retreats with 'Ohana Oasis, and the list continues to grow. It is clear there is a need for grieving parents. A big part of meeting this need is our signature fundraiser, the Giving For Joy Gala. The 3rd annual gala will be held at the Multnomah Athletic Club, in Portland, on November 9th from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm.
